This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of Your information and Your client's information when You use the Service and tells You about the privacy rights of You and Your Clients and how the law protects You and Your Clients.

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions.

The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

You means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Your Client means the individual whose information is collected through Your access and use of the Service.

Company (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Aidia Legal, located at 302-790 boul. Rosemont, Montreal.

- Affiliate means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control
 with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity
 interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing
 authority.
- Account means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- Website refers to the Aidia Legal application, accessible from app.aidialegal.com.
- **Service** refers to the Website.
- **Country** refers to: Quebec, Canada
- Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf
 of the Company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the

- Cookies are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other

Personal Data

Tracking Technologies and Cookies

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on Our Service and store certain information. Tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze Our Service.

Affiliates include Our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that We control or that are under common control with Us.
- **With Business partners:** We may share Your information with Our business partners to offer You certain products, services or promotions.

Use of Your Client's Personal Data

- We do not share Your Client's Personal Data with anyone outside the limits of our Service.
- We use Your Client's Personal Data only within the limits of providing you the functions of our Service.
- We do not sell Your Client's Personal Data.

Retention of Personal Data

The Company will retain Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of Our Service, or We are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of Your data and other personal information.

Law enforcement
